One of their platforms is prison reform, and their “decARcerate” campaign works on progressive sentencing policy reform. The goal of this campaign is to end mass incarceration and eliminate racial and social disparities in the Arkansas criminal punishment system that results in people of color, the poor, and people with mental illness being more harshly treated.
