Project Restitution's mission is to provide the court with a sentencing alternative for offenders that is both constructive and appropriate for the offense. Through its service provision conducted within the District Court system, Project Restitution ensures that victims of crime are repaid for any losses and damages they have suffered. The objective is to make the offenders aware that they are responsible for their actions; that there are consequences to them and others as a result of these actions and when a crime has been committed, the offender has an obligation to the community and to the victims to make amends for their actions. This is accomplished through court-ordered restitution, court-ordered community service or any other court-ordered sanction.
